

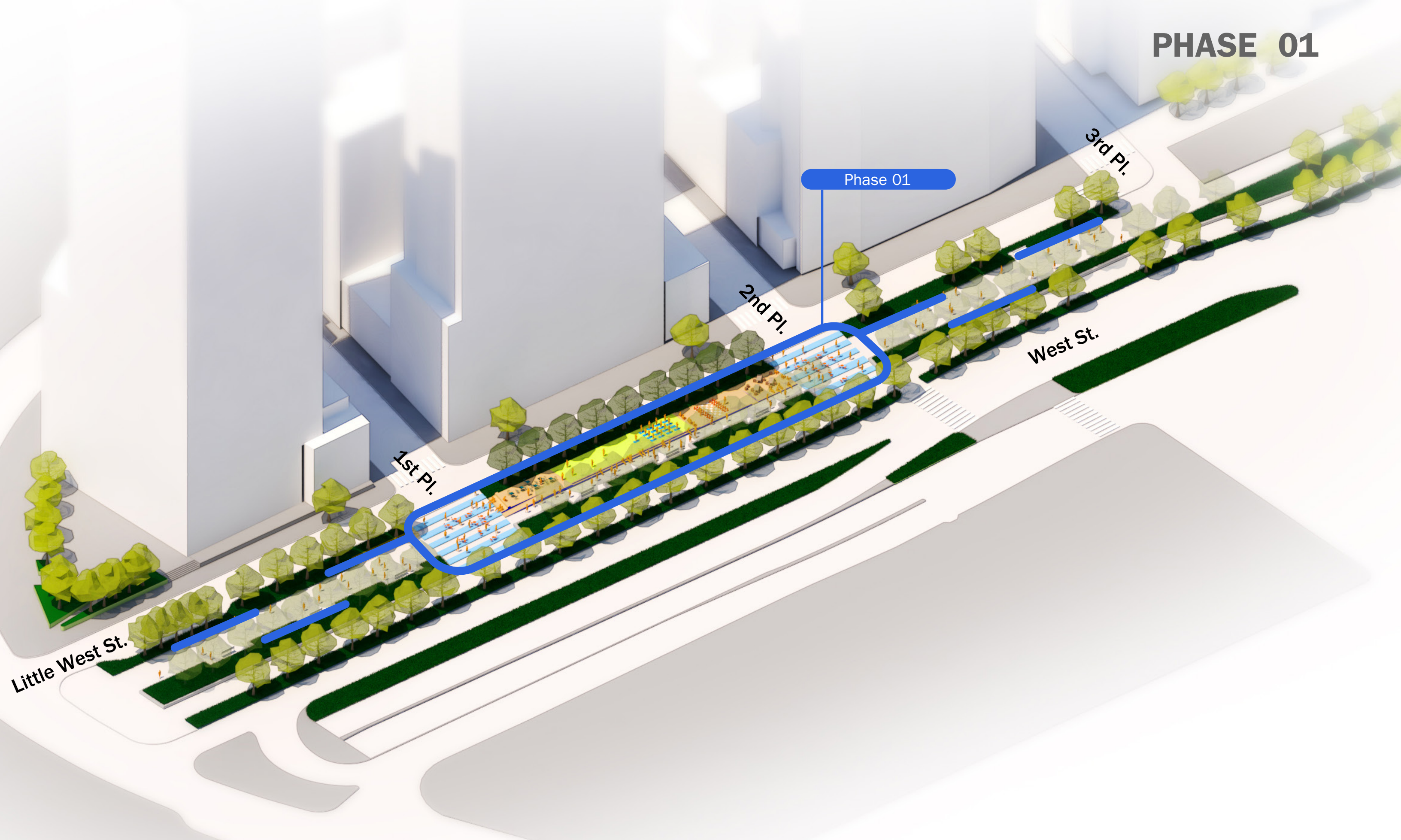

PHASE 01



FLEXIBLE PASSIVE SPACES FOR ADULTS AND KIDS

1. Support kids' after school programs.
2. Pop-up games like chess, knock hockey, etc.
3. Loose furniture, picnic tables and chairs.
4. Keep a light touch.

ACTIVE PLAY AREA FOR OLDER KIDS

1. Secure for ball playing activities.
2. Pop-up table tennis.

ACTIVE PLAY AREA FOR YOUNGER KIDS

1. Recess play area extension space for neighboring schools.
2. Small pop-up play equipment.

CLEAR SEPARATION FOR SAFETY BETWEEN:

1. Active and passive spaces.
2. Older kids zone v. younger children spaces.
3. Play area and pedestrian circulation.
4. Separation from streets.

The Evolving Shoreline

This mural is an artistic representation of the ever-evolving Lower Manhattan shoreline through time. Shown not as a map but as an abstract timeline, from its natural tidal marshes in the 1600s, through the industrial piers built in the mid-1800s, to the land-fill creation of Battery Park City in the 1970s, Lower Manhattan's vibrancy has always been closely tied to the water edge. With climate change upon us and as sea level rises, Battery Park City Authority is advancing coastal resiliency projects to adapt to new climate realities, and to protect the community from future storms, while also reining and enhancing the quality of all public spaces. 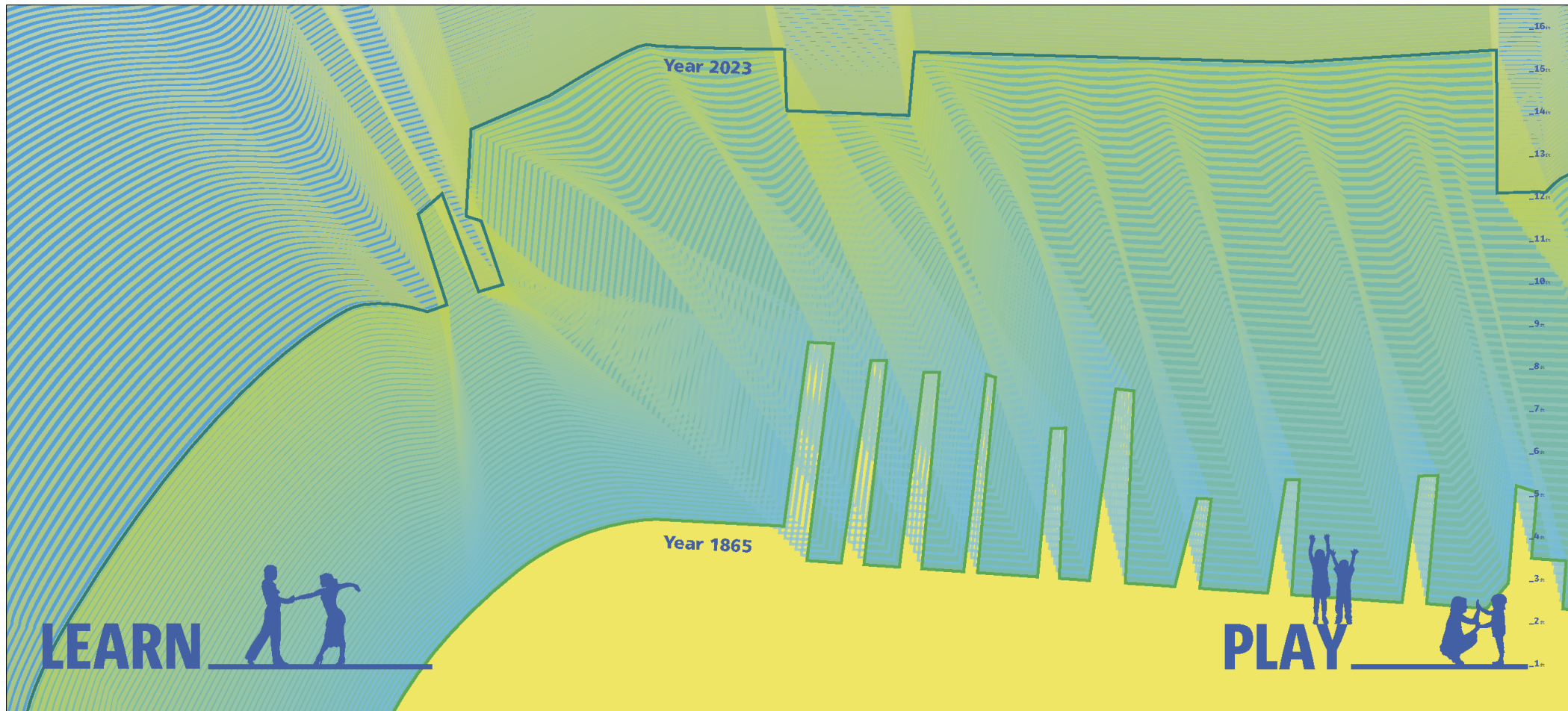
