A) RFP CLARIFICATION:

In response to general inquiries regarding eligibility to submit Proposals, note that the advisory services to be performed under this solicitation are intended to be separate, distinct, and supplementary to the services being performed by consultants already actively engaged by BPCA on its coastal flood resiliency projects. As described in the RFP – upon its selection of the Pre-Qualified Panel as a result of this solicitation, BPCA retains broad discretion to structure and issue advisory consultation assignments in accordance with its strategic goals for its coastal flood resiliency projects.

Accordingly, while firms currently serving as prime consultants or sub-consultants on BPCA resiliency projects will not be precluded from submitting Proposals, such firms should note that, in light of the potential for overlapping or duplication – in whole or in part – of existing contractual obligations; and/or the potential for conflicts of interest, as determined by BPCA at the time a task is ready to be assigned to a selected Proposer, their eligibility for consideration for particular Resiliency Program Advisory Services assignments may be limited, perhaps significantly. Firms currently serving as prime consultants for BPCA resiliency projects with broad existing areas of responsibility will likely be most susceptible to limitations with respect to opportunities for the assignment of tasks in connection with their inclusion on the Pre-Qualified Panel.
