Any unused portions of such Allowance will not be paid to the selected contractor.

- The Form of Cost Proposal constituting <u>Exhibit E</u> to the RFP is hereby superseded by the replacement Exhibit E *Form of Cost Proposal*, appended hereto as Attachment #2.
- The Form of Bid Breakdown constituting <u>Exhibit F</u> to the RFP is hereby superseded by the replacement <u>Exhibit F</u> *Form of Bid Breakdown*, appended hereto as Attachment #3.

#### SECTION 012100 - ALLOWANCES

## PART 1 - GENERAL

#### 1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and other Division 1 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

## 1.2 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes administrative and procedural requirements governing allowances.
  - 1. Certain items are specified in the Contract Documents by allowances. Allowances have been established in lieu of additional requirements and in anticipation of the need for additional structural repairs falling within the project scope, but not included on the project Drawings, at a later date when additional information is available for evaluation. If necessary, additional requirements will be issued by Change Order.

## 1.3 SELECTION AND PURCHASE

- A. At the earliest practical date after award of the Contract, advise BPCA of the need for additional structural repairs.
- B. At BPCA request, obtain proposals for each allowance for use in making final selections. Include recommendations that are relevant to performing the Work.

# 1.4 SUBMITTALS

- A. Submit proposals, in the form specified for Change Orders, identifying any increased quantities of repair work or extra work directed by the Design Engineer.
- B. Submit invoices or delivery slips to show actual quantities of materials delivered to the site for use in fulfillment of each allowance.
- C. Coordinate and process submittals for allowance items in same manner as for other portions of the Work.

# 1.5 COORDINATION

A. Coordinate allowance items with other portions of the Work. Furnish templates as required to coordinate installation.

#### 1.6 ALLOWANCES

A. Allowances shall cover cost to the Contractor for furnishing OR furnishing and installing items specified in 3.3 Schedule of Allowances. Items furnished but not installed will be delivered to a location at the project site or within Battery Park City as directed by the construction manager and will be paid for on a direct cost basis.

## 1.7 UNUSED MATERIALS

- A. Return unused materials purchased under an allowance to manufacturer or supplier for credit to BPCA, after installation has been completed and accepted.
  - If requested by construction manager, prepare unused material for storage by BPCA when it is not economically practical to return the material for credit. If directed by Construction manager, deliver unused material to BPCA storage space. Otherwise, disposal of unused material is Contractor's responsibility.

#### **PART 3 - EXECUTION**

#### 3.1 EXAMINATION

A. Examine products covered by an allowance promptly on delivery for damage or defects. Return damaged or defective products to manufacturer for replacement.

## 3.2 PREPARATION

A. Coordinate materials and their installation for each allowance with related materials and installations to ensure that each allowance item is completely integrated and interfaced with related work.

#### 3.3 SCHEDULE OF ALLOWANCES

A. Allowance No. 1 – Additional Repair: include an allowance of \$160,000 for additional concrete repairs, crack repairs, structural steel repairs, or other added work not otherwise shown on the Contract Documents, at the direction of the Design Engineer. Any unused Allowance will not be paid to the Contractor.

Omission of any Work items from the Bid Breakdown shall not constitute a limit on the obligation of the contractor to complete the Work, nor shall the performance of any portion of the Work not specifically called out in the Bid Breakdown entitle the selected Proposer to additional compensation.
