
## Travel Advisory South Battery Park City Resiliency Project

Starting Thursday, March 14 through Friday, March 15, overnight work will be performed along West Street's southbound lanes in Lower Manhattan. As a result, southbound travel lanes along West Street, between Albany Street and Battery Place, as depicted below, may be reduced by one lane from 9PM to 5:30AM.



The South Battery Park City Resiliency Project (SBPCR) represents one of several projects within the overall Lower Manhattan Coastal Resiliency (LMCR) Master Plan. SBPCR is a BPCA capital project designed to provide flood risk reduction for Battery Park City and Lower Manhattan in response to increasingly frequent and more severe storms.
