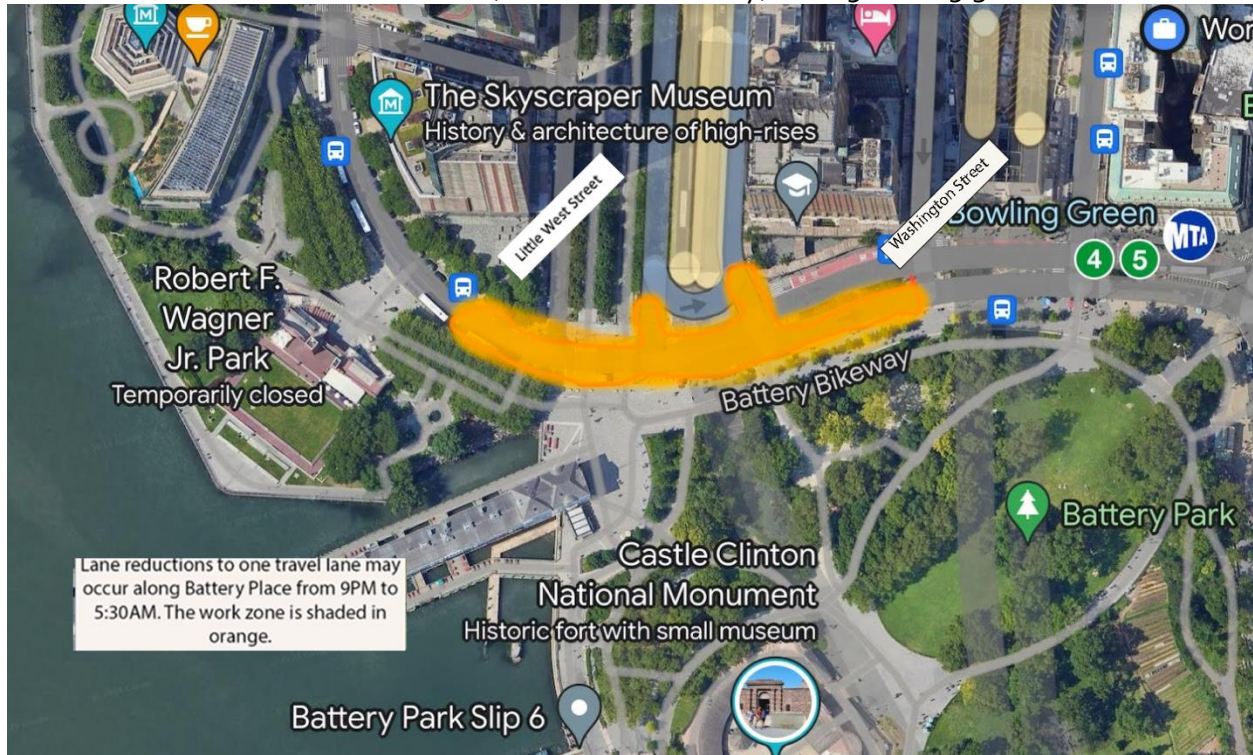


Travel Advisory

South Battery Park City Resiliency Project

Starting Sunday, July 21, night work will be performed along Battery Place in Lower Manhattan to install a 6" watermain and gas main, as well as resurface the street. This work is expected to continue through Friday, July 26. As a result, travel lanes along Battery Place, between Little West Street and Washington Street, as depicted below, may be reduced to one lane in each direction (non-simultaneously) from 9PM to 5:30AM.



The South Battery Park City Resiliency Project (SBPCR) represents one of several projects within the overall Lower Manhattan Coastal Resiliency (LMCR) Master Plan. SBPCR is a BPCA capital project designed to provide flood risk reduction for Battery Park City and Lower Manhattan in response to increasingly frequent and more severe storms.
