North/West Battery Park City Resiliency Project

Opportunity to provide comment on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS)

The North/West Battery Park City Resiliency Project Will:

- Implement a flood barrier system and related improvements in drainage and open space along a project corridor that includes streets and open spaces between the intersection of North Moore Street/Greenwich Street on the north and 1st Place in Battery Park City on the south and includes a crossing of Route 9A/West Street. The majority of the project area is aligned along the waterfront open spaces of Battery Park City. Also included with the proposed project are drainage improvements, including a pump station.
