New York County (Manhattan) - The Battery Park City Authority, as lead agency, has accepted a Draft Environmental Impact Statement on the proposed North/West Battery Park City Resiliency (NWBPCR) Project. **A public hearing on the Draft EIS will be held on September 18, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at the 345 Chambers Street, New York, NY 10282 or Virtual, pre-registration information available at:** nwbpcr-deis-hearing.eventbrite.com. The action involves the design and installation of a flood barrier system and related improvements in drainage and open space along a project corridor that includes streets and open spaces between the intersection of North Moore Street/Greenwich Street on the north and 1st Place in Battery Park City on the south and includes a crossing of Route 9A/West Street. The majority of the project area is aligned along the waterfront open spaces of Battery Park City. Also included in the proposed project are drainage improvements, including a pump station. The project is located at Battery Park City between 1st Place and North Esplanade; Route 9A/West Street and the intersection of North Moore Street and Greenwich Street in Manhattan, New York.
