

South Battery Park City Resiliency Project: Upcoming Two-Week Construction Notification



Project Area: Wagner Park, The Battery
Date: September 13, 2024

The following work, from 7 AM to 6 PM unless otherwise noted, is anticipated through **Friday, September 27, 2024**, but may be subject to change due to scheduling or weather:

- Site demolition and installation of tide gate chamber at Rector Place terminus to facilitate SBPCR [interior drainage elements](#). This work will also include mobilization of dewatering equipment. Once in operation, equipment will be running continuously. Operation will be supervised at all times
- Construction staging in approximately 200 feet of the parking lane on the north side of Rector Place, west of South End Avenue
- Electrical utility installation in the Battery
- Below grade seepage barrier installation in the Battery and Pier A Plaza
- Superstructure construction and utility work for the new Pavilion Building in Wagner Park
- Installation of site utilities, concrete structures, and fill materials in Wagner Park
- Installation of floodwalls around MJH, First Place, and in Wagner Park
- Construction staging in approximately 80 feet of the parking lane on Battery Place
- Material deliveries will continue, with increased truck traffic south of First Place on Battery Place
 - ✓ Flaggers are on-site to direct trucks for public safety and traffic control.
 - ✓ Pedestrian / vehicular access along Battery Place & surrounding streets will be maintained at all times.
