<u>Community Notice</u> <u>South Battery Park City Resiliency Project: Early Morning Work</u>

Ahead of Wagner Park's reopening on July 29, construction trailers will be removed from the work site on Wednesday, July 16. Due to their size, this activity must be completed in the early morning hours and is scheduled to begin at 4:00 a.m. The trailers will be temporarily staged on First Place, where they will be picked up and removed from the site entirely. This work may be noisy, but it will not impact traffic flow on First Place.
