

South Battery Park City Resiliency Project: Upcoming Two-Week Construction Notification

The following work, from 7 AM to 11 PM including weekends unless otherwise noted, is anticipated through **Friday, April 3, 2026**, but may be subject to change due to scheduling or weather:

- Installation of stone on flood wall at Battery Place
- Installation of staircases at Pier A Plaza
- Installation of retaining wall at Pier A Plaza
- Installation of bollards at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- Installation of drainage at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- Ground hydrant Installation at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- Electrical conduit installation at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- The Wagner Park pavilion bathrooms will be closed on Tuesday, March 24 and Wednesday, March 25 to allow for vapor barrier testing.
- Material deliveries to Pier A Plaza and Greenwich Street
- Flaggers are on-site to direct trucks for public safety and traffic control.
- Pedestrian/vehicular access along Battery Place and surrounding streets will be maintained at all times.

- Pier A Plaza and Battery Place evening work will start at 3 PM and end at 11 PM, Monday through Friday, and 7 AM to 6 PM on Saturday. This work is anticipated to continue for approximately 10 weeks. Work is not anticipated to take place on Sunday. The team will perform excavations, grading, building of concrete forms, and concrete pours, weather permitting. Truck traffic will be present and deliveries will take place. An excavator will be working on site; some noise is anticipated to be associated with this work. The team will use light towers directed at the relevant work areas, not facing the street.
