

South Battery Park City Resiliency Project: Upcoming Two-Week Construction Notification

Project Area: Wagner Park, The Battery

The following work is anticipated through
Friday, June 26, 2026, but may be subject to change due to scheduling or weather:

- Electrical conduit and electric cable installation at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- Stonework on staircase at Pier A Plaza
- Installation of pavers at Pier A Plaza and Battery Place
- Installation of retaining walls at Battery Place
- Soil and tree installation at Battery Place
- Curb work and road base for bike lane at Battery Place
- Installation of planters at public restrooms at Battery Place
- Excavation and installation of aggregate at Washington and West Streets
- Material deliveries to Pier A Plaza and Greenwich Street
- Flaggers are on-site to direct trucks for public safety and traffic control.
- Pedestrian/vehicular access along Battery Place and surrounding streets will be maintained at all times.
- **Lower Pier A Plaza is now open with connections to Wagner Park and Battery Park, as well as the crossing from Verrazzano Monument to Battery Place.**
- Pier A Plaza and Battery Place work will start at 7 AM and end at 3 PM and evening work will start at 3 PM and end at 11 PM. Additional shifts will work at 9 PM to 5AM (until 6/19), 7 AM to 6 PM on Saturday, and 7 AM to 3:30 PM on Sundays. Two shifts will resume on June 20, 2026. This work is anticipated to continue for approximately 4 weeks. The team will perform excavations, grading, building of concrete forms, and concrete pours, weather permitting. Truck traffic will be present and deliveries will take place. An excavator will be working on site; some noise is anticipated to be associated with this work. The team will use light towers directed at the relevant work areas, not facing the street.
