Description: BPCA requests proposals (individually a “Proposal” and collectively the “Proposals”) from Design Professionals (individually a “Proposer” and collectively the “Proposers”) to provide BPCA with Urban Design Services (the “Services”), which are set forth in greater detail in the detailed scope of work for which the selected Proposer will be responsible, attached hereto as Exhibit A, but which shall include, but not be limited to:

- (1) Synthesize relevant existing studies, plans, and available neighborhood data and assess physical condition.
- (2) Develop concept-level frameworks for public space and streetscape improvements, including a review of relevant precedents from New York City and comparable urban contexts.

- (3) Conduct a Community Engagement process which will refine concepts and priorities.
- (4) Develop a phased implementation strategy with high-level cost estimates for recommended public space and streetscape improvements.
- (5) Prepare a final report and presentation materials documenting findings, recommendations, implementation priorities, and next-step planning.

New York State-certified Minority-Owned Business Enterprises (“MBE”), Women-Owned Business Enterprises (“WBE”) and Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises (“SDVOB”) are encouraged to submit Proposals.
